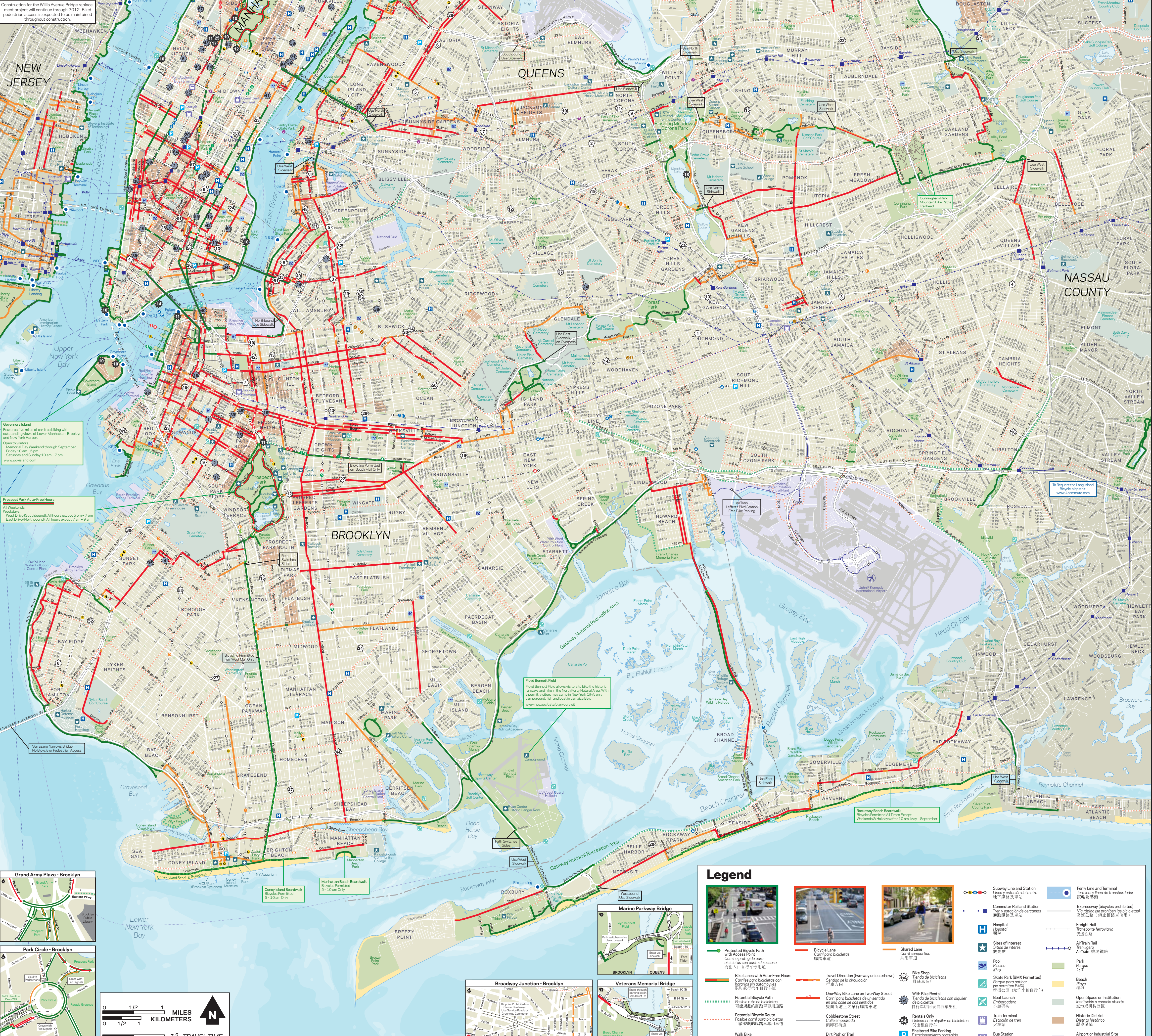

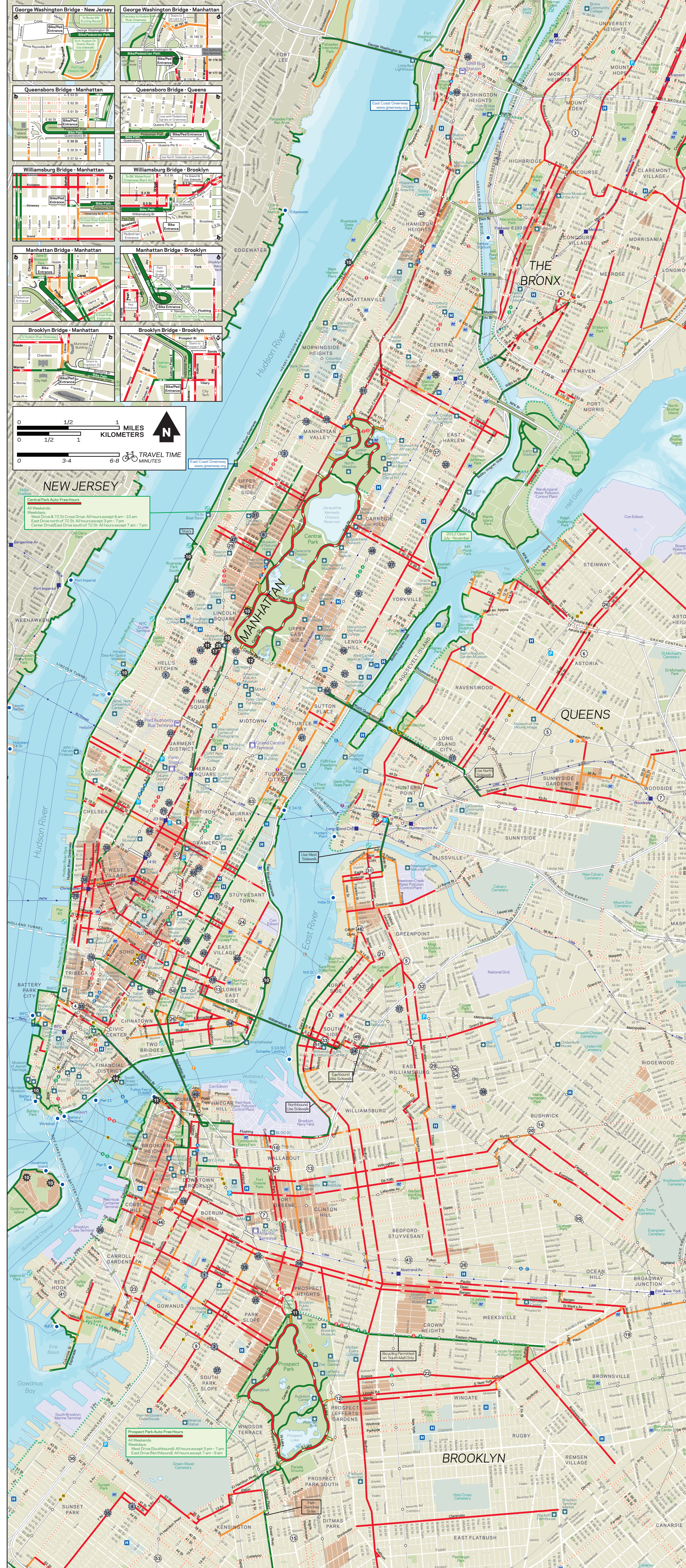
NYC Biking Laws

- Yield to pedestrians**
Ceda el paso a los peatones
讓路給行人
- Ride in the direction of traffic**
Circule en el sentido del tráfico cuando ande en bicicleta
朝交通方向騎車
- Use a white front light and red tail light at night**
Use uno luz delantera blanco y uno luz trasera roja durante la noche
晚上使用白色頭燈和紅色尾燈
- Stop at red lights and stop signs**
Deténgase en las luces rojas del semáforo y las señales de pare
在紅燈和紅字標誌前停車
- Stay off the sidewalk unless you're under 13**
No use las aceras a menos que tengas menos de 13 años de edad
離開人行道 除非你是13歲以下

Tips for the Ride

- Use a white front light and red tail light at night**
Use uno luz delantera blanco y uno luz trasera roja durante la noche
- Yield in mixing zones**
Merge in front of or behind turning cars. Take the full lane & don't hug the curb.
- Avoid wearing headphones**
By law, you may only wear one earbud. Clear ears are safer.
- Ring your bell**
Bells are required by law. Ring to alert others to your presence.
- Use bike boxes to make turns**
The box gives you space of red lights for a head start or making turns.
- Stay 3 ft from parked cars**
If cars can't pass you with three feet to spare, take the lane.
- Watch the road**
Avoid steel grates and utility covers, especially when wet. Call 311 to report potholes.

Subway Tips

- Avoid Rush Hour
- Use the service gate for entry/exit
- Carry your bike on the stairs
- Hold your bike at all times

Restrictions

- Bicycles allowed at all times:** NYC Subway, Staten Island Ferry, Governors Island Ferry, SeaStreak, Landmark Bicycles, NY Waterway/East River Ferry, New York Water Taxi.
- Bicycles not allowed except folding NYC:** MTA AirTrain.

Riding and Locking Tips

Making Turns

- LEFT
- RIGHT
- STOP

Lock it Right

- Lock your wheels to your frame.
- Lock all "quick release" parts.
- Lock your bike with a U-Lock or heavy chain. Do not lock to trees or subway rails.
