Writing to me is a way to express myself. In this class I've learned a different way to write in a scientific way. I've also learned not just to write in a scientific way but also read and understand what to look for in these type of writings. Here I will be focusing in the improvements I have made throughout this class. I have made many mistakes, but I have also learned what my mistakes are. I will be honest and say that writing scares me because I am not very confident in my writing skills. I believe that by writing more and more and reading more and more will give me confidence, and self-understanding in what I am good at and what I can improve with my writing.

I will start with the group's final paper. This was a challenge for me since it was announced that it would be a group final paper. With this paper I had to learn to communicate better with my partners and understand their writing styles and their ideas. With this paper the outcome was very informative and everyone in the group new their parts and their topics. Besides some grammatical errors, this paper had sections in certain topics that were more elaborate and others that did not have much information to go on. As I revised this paper, I made some changes for the mental health section and added more information on the topic.
