

ESL DC 2019: **Report on Voting**

To recommend an ESL placement test and the CUNY ESL DC Resolution on acceleration and ESL position at the University for consideration in the upcoming University Chancellery decision-making, the ESL DC conducted an electronic email vote on December 13, 2019. 16 colleges are eligible to vote. John Jay was not counted, as there has been no official representative.

The process:

Each voting member was contacted via e-mail with choices sent out by Lubie. Voting was monitored by the ESL DC membership coordinator, Weier Ye. Lubie, Cindy, and Weier respectively kept the tally.

Each ESL DC representative cast one vote for an ESL placement test and one vote YEY, NEY, or ABSTRAIN for the ESL DC Resolution. For the ESL placement test, each voting member selected one option from the set of the following **5 ballot choices**:

1. CATW
2. CATW-E
3. MET
4. Accuplacer White Paper
5. Extended Reading for CATW-E
