Nominations are made by departments that are members of CCFLS who write a brief letter of support and forward up-to-date curricula vitae, copies of publications, and/or evidence of professional presentations and creative works to the CUNY Council Award and Scholarship Committee. This committee consists of four council representatives from different institutions, currently Alicia Ramos (Hunter College), Maan Lin (QCC), Liliana Soto-Fernández (John Jay), Lorena Ellis, (QCC).
